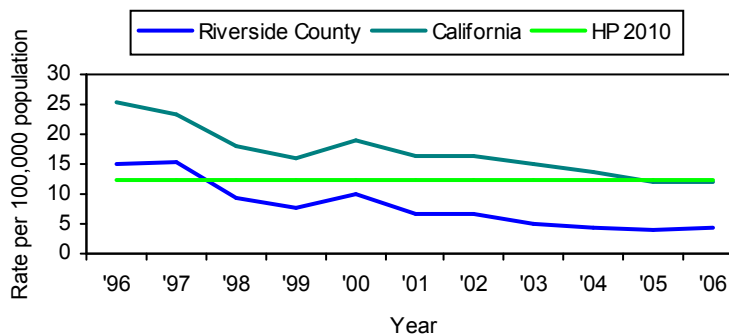


CAMPYLOBACTERIOSIS

DISEASE ABSTRACT

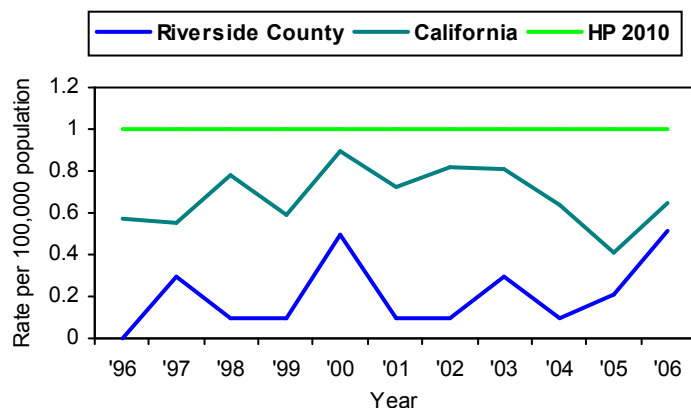
- Eighty-five cases of campylobacteriosis were reported in 2006, with an incidence rate of 4.4 cases per 100,000 population.
- Since 1998, Riverside County incidence rates for campylobacteriosis have been below the Healthy People 2010 objective of 12.3 cases per 100,000 population.

DISEASE ABSTRACT

- E. Coli O157:H7 is rarely reported in Riverside County with an average of three cases per year, and an incidence rate well below the Healthy People 2010 goal of one case per 100,000 population.
- However, in 2006, Riverside County reported 10 outbreak-related cases.

GIARDIASIS

DISEASE ABSTRACT

- Thirty-six cases of giardiasis were reported in 2006 with an incidence rate of 1.9 cases per 100,000 population.
- The decline in incidence rate of giardiasis in Riverside County has leveled off with the current rate of reported disease one-tenth
